

The Victory City system makes these job transfers as painless and inexpensive as possible. Since all apartments in VC are completely furnished, there is no expense in moving furniture. Since there are no kitchens or dining rooms, there are no dishes & glasses etc. to pack. Since everyone lives in apartments, there are no houses to sell, often at a loss and delay in moving time. All you do is pack your bags and go. If you are moving to another VC, you could make reservations in advance.

The VC system is another example of how VC promotes progress while accomodating individuals. Expect more job transfers in the future. VC will be ready.

NO CEMETERIES

Land is too precious in support of the life of the living to waste on the dead who do not need it. Therefore VC will have no cemeteries. Bodies may be cremated, sent to cemeteries in old obsolete cities for burial or disposed of in some other manner. Perhaps a large garbage disposal could be designed to dispose of cadavers. The residue could fertilize the farmland. This method would eliminate air pollution due to cremation. The extravagant ever increasing cost of funerals, as people compete to make them more lavish, could be eliminated. Cadavers could be turned over to VC for free unceremoneous disposal.

ATOMIC BOMB SHELTER

If finances permit, VC's will be connected with other cities, particularly other VC's, by electric trains operating in a subway deep underground. The subway would be round and constructed of reinforced poured concrete. About 10-15 miles or more away from VC atomic bomb shelters would be located next to the subway. There would be numerous subways radiating from VC like the spokes of a wheel. There would be numerous atomic shelters scattered underground altogether sufficient to provide space and support the life of the total VC population. All shelters would be connected electronically for communication. There would also be underground power plants, ventilating system, water system, food distribution system etc.

The instant an enemy nation launches missiles with atomic warheads destined for our country, the alarms will sound throughout VC, and all the people there will immediately board the thousands of elevators which will drpp them down deep underground to the subway stations directly under the VC building, where they will board the electric trains which will speed them to the various atomic bomb shelters.

The entire city could be evacuated in 15-20 minutes. No such system would be possible in an old obsolete city.

The shelters' food system could include cafeterias which would be operating in normal times along with the electric trains. This would familiarize the people with the underground facilities and help finance the total cost.
