Dear Mr. Tatum:


Enclosed are copies of our previous correspondence and literature concerning the latest and hottest thing in food service for restaurants, the Circl-Serv, manufactured by B.W. Metals Co., 33 Donald Dr., Fairfield, Ohio 45014.

I have heard nothing from your people in your planning and design organization for EPCOT, however, I now have a concept for a Victory City cafeteria designed to be an operating exhibit at EPCOT featuring the Circl-Serv. 10,000 people per meal could be fed. Homer Duff, the owner of Duff's Enterprises and the B.W. Metals Co., informed me that the Circl-Serv could be made in any diameter to accomodate whatever number of customers you might expect.
