VC Cafeteria

Features the Circl-Serv. Will feed 13,000 people in 3 hours.

People enter on left side of picture, cross the bridge, go around circular ramp and take any of 48 ferris wheels which circle the ramp and take a  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn down to the Circl-Serv where they can get their meal in 30 seconds. Then they take another  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn down to the main dining floor where they are surrounded by a ring of cashiers. They can use any of them and proceed out to any table.

The dinosaur pictures on surrounding walls would be similar to those in the Field Museum of Natural History in Chicago. This way we combine the museum with the cafeteria in order to get 2 for the price of 1. We have to decorate the walls with something. So why not something fascinating and educational in a setting of dramatic beauty.

VC Map & Overall City Plan
