

In the average Victory City, it will be possible to go from any one place to any other, anywhere in the building in only 5 to 10 minutes and without any hurrying. The number of automobile accidents that will be eliminated will stagger the imagination for the simple reason that auto travel will be limited to travel between Victory City and other cities. Within Victory City all the transportation will be elevators for the vertical transportation and electric cars for horizontal transportation. The electric cars will be so safe that even children will be allowed to drive them. Distances will be so short on any one floor that most people will probably walk most of the time. The safe and free elevators, I presume, will be used constantly by most everyone.

In a matter of seconds, these high speed elevators can drop you down to the first floor, and the minute you step outside the building, you are more than outside, you are in the country, breathing clean, clear, fresh country air. There will be no other building in sight, not even a farmhouse because the farm operator will live in Victory City in style.

There will be a wide variety of living accommodations. There will be something for everyone, and something for everyone's pocketbook from the least expensive to the most expensive and everything in between. The least expensive will be a ward for perhaps 50 people. Each would have a bunk and small locker. All 50 would share the same bathroom. There would be wards for men, wards for woman, for students, for the retired and elderly, for the poor, for surplus population as temporary quarters, etc.

#### MONEY SYSTEM - VICTORY CITY

In all business transactions no money will be used.

Instead everyone will carry a bankbook which will have his photo on it to identify him. Whenever he buys an item in a store, he will always pay for the item immediately by handing the clerk his bankbook, which the clerk would insert in a specially designed machine that would be hooked up electronically with another machine in the one and only bank in Victory City. The clerk then operates the machine to deduct the amount of the sales from the latest balance in the bankbook and simultaneously deduct the same amount from the bank's record of the individual and add it to the store's bank balance.

Apartment rental will be deducted automatically each month.

The next time the individual is paid his wages or salary, his employer, a company, would insert the company's bankbook in a machine to deduct the man's salary from the company's bank balance and add it to the employee's bank balance. The next time he uses his bankbook at the store, in the cafeteria or anywhere else, the salary will be added on automatically.
