

In addition to a package delivery slot, there will be a smaller one for letters. No stamps needed.

The P.O. boxes could be rented from the post office by the tenants or every tenant could be supplied a P.O. box by V.C. and the cost added to the rent and then this amount paid by V.C. in one lump sum to the post office.

The best way of all is for the post office to supply the boxes free of charge since it will cost them less to put mail in P.O. boxes than to hire the additional mailmen that would be needed to deliver each person's mail to his apt. door as is done in the old obsolete cities, where the doors are scattered a distance totalling 10, 15 & 20 miles. In V.C. the apt. doors are concentrated and orderly and the P.O. boxes even more so. Therefore it is only fair that P.O. boxes be supplied free and even so the government will save money thanks to V.C.

SCHOOL SYSTEM V.C.

The old fashioned traditional school system will be kept intact and complete from nursery school & kindergarden through college. All, including college, will be free to all students who are permanent residents of V.C. and all the costs will be financed by V.C. out of the gross rental income. Since students will be living permanently in V.C., presumably with parents, the need for dormitories are eliminated.

In addition to the traditional school system, which is kept for those who value it highly, will be another free educational system, which may ultimately be more important and significant than the traditional one. The new one will in many or most instances utilize the same subject and classes of the old. The difference being that in the new system the students may take exams but will not be required to, they may go into a higher grade without passing the grade they are in. A second grade student may sit in for example a 5th grade class to audit it. Auditing will be encouraged. A 5th grader might audit a high school class and a high school student might audit a college class. A student auditing classes may take exams in it if he wishes, and if he passes the exams he must be given the same credit or degrees that the regular students receive. The purpose of this will be to encourage the individual to find and develop his own interests and develop his own individuality which is a fundamental part of specialization, and the capitalistic free enterprise system.

In both new and old systems there will be a major shift in the curriculum. Useless old cultural subjects will be greatly de-emphasized and new scientific, technical, business and professional subjects will be very prominent and greatly encouraged.

The way to determine the value of any subject is to ask what the value of this subject will be 100 years from now, 1000 years from now, 1 million years and 100 million years from now etc.
