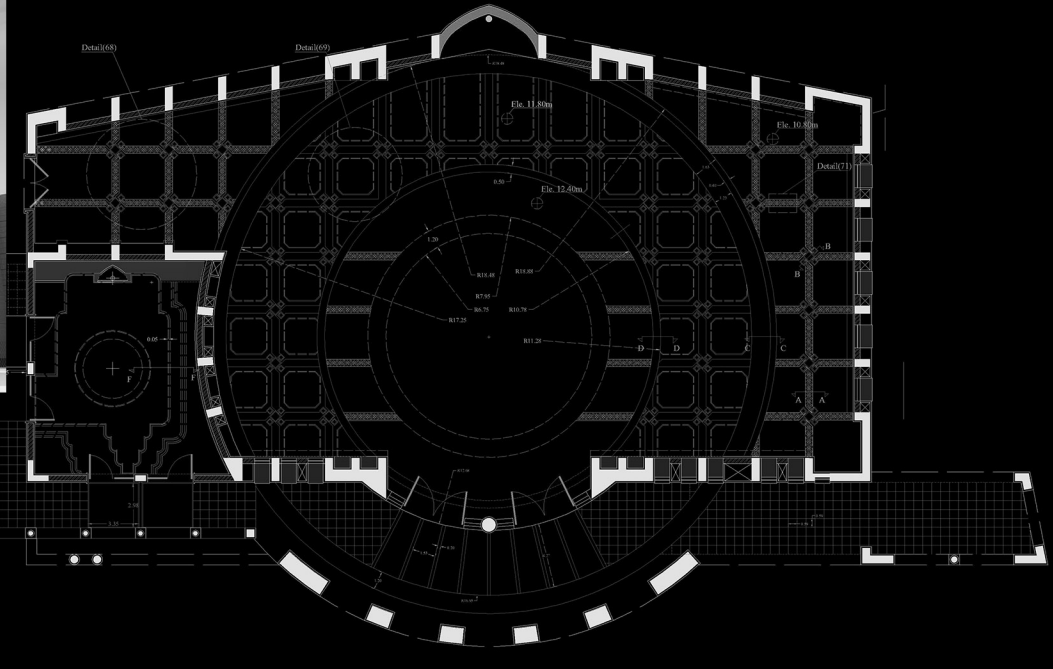


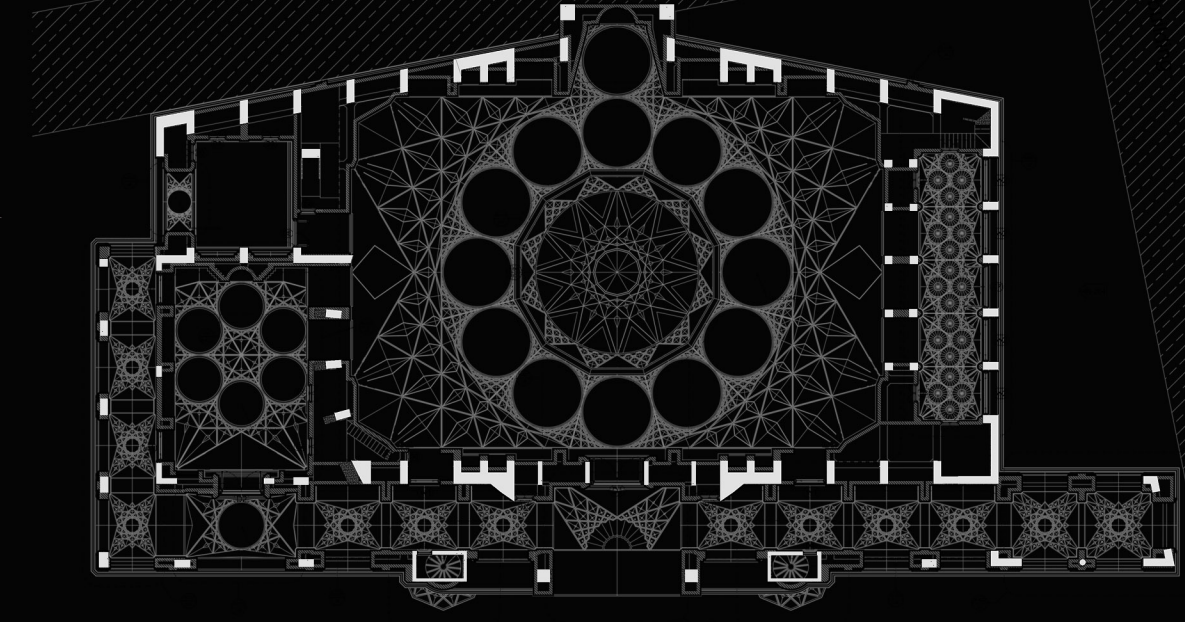
In 2006, a new design for the place was suggested. People, both visitors and pilgrims, rejected it, yet by 2008 50% of the structure had already been constructed, and it was at this point that we began work redesigning the project.

SECTION I-2006-2008



In 2010, we submitted our design to repurpose the old structure. We avoided demolition as much as we could, yet added some columns and beams. This design depended on the original architectural language of the site. We suggested using silver and gold in certain places, since all Iraqi sacred sites use these materials, and people who visit such places see gold in particular as something that differentiates mosques from shrines.
