Cincinnati Community Video (CCV) showed the above described film along with the original "Raw Footage" exclusively of Victory City and 48 minutes long. The final version was 12 minutes. Both were shown on Channel 7 & 10 several times. Later amateurs volunteered and produced a CCV film of VC which was shown numerous times. This was entitled "Visions of the Future". 
The films made so far are mostly interviewing, questions and answers, and very little of the drawings and plans shown. I would like to have a film made of broadcast quality that could be shown nationwide, that would include all the picture drawings and all or most of the plan drawings. Also I would like to have all important VC subject matter included and explained in greater detail. An hour would be the minimum time for good results. There probably is enough material to consider a series.

Public knowledge of Victory City is a vital preliminary step in the building of the first VC. I will give all my VC plans free of charge to any builder who is capable of building the first small VC of one unit for 37,500 people. This would cost billions of dollars. It is important that private enterprise build this, not government. In order to raise the necessary capital, I assume, common stock would have to be sold to the public. In this case, I would be among the first to buy VC common stock.
