to the back of the board. All original drawings will be retained by the sponsors of the competition and in the case of publication the student's name and his identification with the University of Cincinnati will be guaranteed. Each entrant is encouraged to make a photocopy of his or her submittal.

Stage Two: Submission of drawings are limited to three 24"x36" boards. Minimum requirements include one overall view of the city, a full site plan, a full cross section linking the city to the landscape, and a color drawing of the exterior of the city. Additional drawings necessary to fully explain the entrant's ideas are encouraged, but may not exceed the three required boards.

A typed text, not to exceed five pages in length explaining the drawings and ideas must be included with the submittal.

Each finalist is to supply their name, mailing address and telephone number in a sealed envelope securely taped to the back of one board. No identifying marks may be present on any board or typed text.

All original drawings will be retained by the sponsor and in the case of publication the student's name and identification with the University of Cincinnati will be guaranteed.
